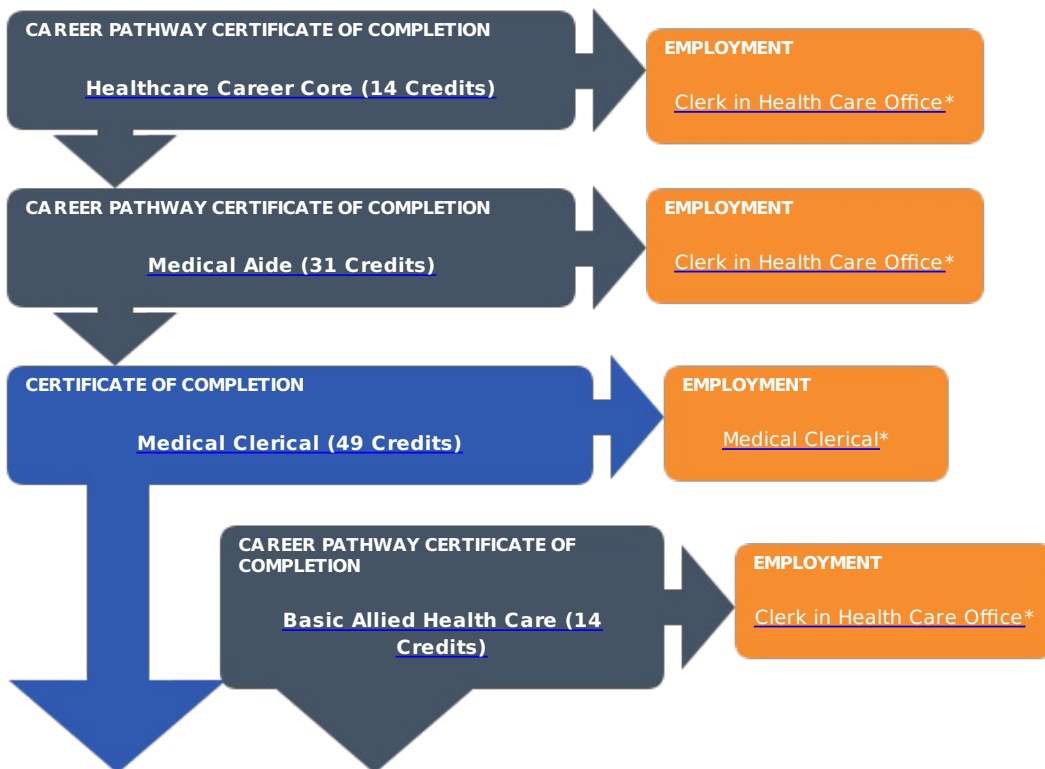

- **Prerequisites:** All courses in this program must be completed with a "C" or better. OA121 Keyboarding. CIS90 or demonstrate proficiency. MTH20 or placement test score. WR90 or placement test score.
- **Admissions:** This is a restricted-entry program and students must submit a separate application along with their college admission application. Applications are now being accepted for the 2017-2018 cohort. - **Benefits:** The Associate of Applied Science in Medical Assistant prepares students in the first year of the curriculum to perform initial clerical duties in hospitals, medical clinics, and other medical facilities. The second year adds skills in medical terminology, management, and clinical skills with emphasis on the role of the medical assistant in the medical care delivery team.
