A Medical Assistant courses are offered by Clatsop Community College and require admission to their program.

Career Pathway Certificate - Medical Assistant

16 Credits

The Career Pathway Certificate will provide training for employment opportunities in healthcare offices and clinics. It requires only a 3-month training commitment. All courses fit with ClatsopCC's One-Year Certificate for Medical Assistant which provides additional training and clinical experience as well as qualifies completers for national certification.
