Tillamook Bay Community College has developed a partnership with Portland Community College and Tillamook County General Hospital to provide training for medical laboratory technicians in Tillamook County. This degree is granted by Portland Community College. TBCC offers program prerequisites, general education, and related coursework. All Medical Laboratory Technology (MLT) courses are offered by Portland Community College and require admission to their program.

PHLEBOTOMY TRAINING AT TBCC

Phlebotomy Part I and Phlebotomy Part II are a two-term course sequence that prepares participants for a career in phlebotomy. Covers collecting, handling, transporting, and processing blood specimens for analysis; laboratory information systems; anatomy and physiology of body systems; pathological conditions; use/care of lab equipment; monitoring quality control. Part II includes 100 hours of clinical experience.
